



免费英语支持课程

1. 免费语言班课程类型

- 凡就读 ELB 或 Gateway 的学生，均有机会获得 2/9/10/17 周的语言课程学费减免（注意：减免外的语言课程学费需照常缴纳）。

2. 获得语言班课程学费减免条件

- 仅限国际学生。
- 主课开课时间为 2022 年 01 月 01 日之后。
- 学费减免仅适用于科廷大学位于西澳州的校区。
- 学费减免仅适用于科廷大学语言课程。
- 在语言课程结束后，学生需在科廷大学就读至少 1 年，课程类型不限，包括本科、硕士或研究型课程。

3. 其他注意事项

- 该学费减免政策没有名额限制，无需额外申请，届时将自动审理。
- 学生需在获得 offer 后的 4 周内，确认接受。
- 如果学生未能满足结课要求，无法按时通过语言课程，学生可以在科廷语言中心的允许下重新就读，若顺利完成第二次语言课程，减免的语言课程费用同样会转移至后期的专业课程费用，但是学生依旧需要缴纳相应的课程费用。如果学生最终依旧没有通过语言课程，那么将失去获得语言课程学费减免的机会。
- 科廷学院的学生同样有机会获得学费减免，待学生顺利就读科廷大学专业课程后，减免的语言课程费用会转移至专业课程费用。
- 对于已满足科廷大学入学语言要求，但自行要求参加语言课程的学生，需照常缴纳相应费用。
- 对于仅需就读 10 周 ELB 语言课程的学生，还可获得 270 澳币的注册费用减免，其他课程学生需照常缴纳注册费用。

- 仅限全额缴费且已接受科廷大学条件录取通知书的国际学生（即不适用于澳洲公民或永居签证持有者）。
- 仅限未能满足科廷大学入学语言要求的学生，且需在录取通知书标注日期一年内进入科廷大学就读主课课程。
- 学生需通过科廷大学语言课程满足科廷大学入语言要求。
- 学生需在完成语言课程后，继续在科廷大学就读至少一年的本科、硕士或研究学位课程，且需注册满 100 学分。
- 在就读语言课程及主流课程的第一学期期间，学生需维持全额付款的国际学生身份，若在中途身份发生改变（如获得澳洲国籍或永居签证）则需要缴纳全部课程费用。
- 若学生未能完成科廷主课课程第一学期，则也需要缴纳全部课程费用。
- 若学生在语言课程结束后，需先进入科廷学院就读，则语言课程学费减免将会在该生进入科廷大学后方可生效。
- 若学生未能满足科廷语言课程要求，需再一次进行科廷语言课程，科廷将不会再次给予学费减免机会，学生也需重新支付语言课程相应费用。
- 学生在接受录取通知书时，需缴纳录取通知书规定费用，以确保获得科廷大学学生身份。
- 被减免的学费无法以现金或其他形式返还。
- 学生需在收到录取通知书的 4 周内确认是否接受。
- 被减免的学费无法转至科廷大学非西澳校区或其他教育机构。
